## BY-LAWS – ARTICLE NINE – MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS

All members in good standing, their relatives and their guests who accompany them shall have full use of the recreation areas owned by Three Rivers Estates Property Owners, Inc. This use shall include, but not be limited to, swimming, boating, picnicking and other recreation. Said recreation areas will be owned, operated, controlled and managed by the corporation. It is the intent of this corporation that utilization of said recreation areas be limited exclusively to lot owners in Three Rivers Estates, their relatives and their guests who accompany them. Use of the recreation areas by groups shall be in limited scope and number. Where the group using or planning to use a recreation area or areas exceeds or is expected to exceed twelve (12) persons in number, then permission for such use shall be first obtained from the president or vice-president or person designated by the president to act upon such request and in no event shall such approval be unreasonably withheld. No other persons or groups of non-members shall be permitted to use the recreation areas without prior approval of the Board of Directors with such approval duly noted in the minutes of the Board meeting. The officers of the corporation and their designees are directed to take such action as they may deem appropriate to prosecute trespassers and prevent unauthorized use of any of the recreation areas under the control of the corporation.
