8. Secretary's Report, Hilda Gilchrist: We had a budget planning session on the 5th.

9. Treasurer's Report, Vicky Seller's:

*When she received bill from Pellonis's, she noticed a 30% increase since their bill in July, so she called them and they said they'd had a rate increase. So she called others for comparisons:

Pelloni's:

Porta Porty Rentals of Bayonnette:

\$ 90.00 per unit per month Plus Tax

\$198.00 Plus tax \$180.00 Plus tax

Fort white Porta Potty out of High Springs

so she called Pelloni's to negotiate and they decided to give us \$110.00 credit for the month, since they had us set up to do an extra servicing on the 4 PP's which would have been an extra \$240/ month, so Charlie agreed to give us \$111.00 credit so instead of the bill being \$796.00, it went down to \$568. She also requested that the Porta potties only be serviced once a week, especially now that the summer is over in the water is coming up. They said in the summer months if we decide to go back to two services a week, we would have to let them know.

*Then she called Kinetic/Windstream about our bill, which is over \$400 a month for the Internet and all the equipment that is at Hodor. She complained and they agreed to give us \$30 off a mont for one year, which will amount to \$360. Then on the other Kinetic bill for &152. for the boat ramp on the Columbia side they agreed to give us \$20 a year reduction for a year which will amount to \$240. Then he found there is a charge for a router on the boat ramp and he's removing that completely... not removing the router, just the \$11 a month.

Summary: between Pelloni's and Kinetic, we will be saving \$2,000 in 2025. * Reminder, 3 bids are required for all work that is not emergency need.. *Our CD mature this Saturday, consensus to leaving it in place along with the profits. *Motion to approve August Financial report: Gloria/Sammy, motion passes

Matthews's analyzed** them in detail and made a recommendation to go with Holly Electric, with a contingency allowing up to \$8,000.00.
